

Historical Lisbon: Baixa - Belém

This is a visit that offers a walking tour through three of the most notable historical districts of Lisbon. Namely *Baixa Pombalina*, *Bairro Alto* and *Belém*.

These areas represent three particular planning and architectural experiences from eighteenth century, sixteenth century but also twentieth century, which are representative of Lisbon urban evolution. The focus of the visit is to explore the various public spaces that make part of these three districts, in order to explore the various urban form solutions and inherent urban character.

The morning visit will start at *Baixa* and includes a visit to *Miradouro São Pedro de Alcântara* in order to allow an aerial view of downtown *Baixa*. After lunch, at *Cervejaria Trindade*, the afternoon tour will follow with a walking through *Bairro Alto* district streets and alleys. The tour will finish with visit to the monumental and historical area of *Belém*, by the Tagus River site.
